



THE VINEYARD ♦ These grapes were grown within the original 1868 parcel of ToKalon Vineyard nestled in the Oakville AVA. The soils are gravelly Bale Clay Loam. It is 100% Clone 214 Cabernet franc on 110R rootstock planted in 2016. This is the first vintage from these vines and it is very, very promising!

GROWING SEASON ♦ The 2021 vintage was a beautiful vintage for Oakville. Vine growth and yields were reduced by drought. The growing season was long and moderate. We picked these grapes at 27.4 Brix on October 7th.

WINEMAKER TASTING NOTES ♦ This wine is more generous and plush than the OFV Cabernet. Black fruit compote and floral aromas dominate with a subtle black olive note. Label by: Dust Cloud Design
